The truck loading apron at the GM plant in Oshawa, ON was susceptible to standing water after heavy rain. This was causing problems for drivers and warehouse staff.

To keep the apron free of water, \$300K PowerDrain was used on the heavily trafficked delivery area. Its large hydraulic capacity ensures that ponding water is no longer an issue. PowerDrain S300K was also chosen for its Load Class F rating, as the apron area has constant fork lift and heavy truck traffic. The heavy duty system, ductile iron grates and anti-shunt lugs in the ductile iron rail ensure that PowerDrain has no problem standing up to the daily abuse it receives from the heavy and turning traffic.
