

Conservation specialists working at the Waterton Lakes National Park in Calagary, discovered that the roadways were a hazard to the endangered salamanders natural habitat. The salamanders migratory paths crossed the roadways and during migration, many were being killed as they crossed the roadways.

A tunnel system was built into the road complex around the park to

allow the Salamanders safe passage beneath the road.

The AT500 is an 18" wide tunnel t hat is rated to load class D to ensure the safety to both salamanders and drivers.

ACO Wildlife recycled plastic, tunnel entrance and fence systems were used to guide the Salamanders into the tunnels.
